# Construction Notice Wards Corner Substation Improvements

Dear Sir or Madam:

Please find below a link to an electronic copy of a Construction Notice that Duke Energy Ohio, Inc., (Duke Energy Ohio) has filed with the Ohio Power Siting Board regarding its proposed project to add approximately 800 feet of new transmission line just outside the substation along the west side of the property. The new transmission line on Duke Energy Ohio property will be supported by 8 steel poles, ranging from 69 feet to 142 feet above ground. The width of the base of the poles is approximately 6-feet in diameter, with a concrete foundation ranging from 8 to 9 feet in diameter. The equipment is designed to withstand the extreme summer temperatures as well as the plunging temperatures in the winter months. The work also will involve the removal of a lattice tower on Duke Energy Ohio property.

In accordance with O.A.C. 4906-1-01 Appendix A, we are required to prepare this Construction Notice for the Ohio Power Siting Board and, in compliance with O.A.C. 4906-6-07, we are hereby providing you with a link to an electronic copy.
