ACCESS FIBER GROUP, INC. (“AFG”) SEEKS AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE FACILITIES-BASED AND RESOLD SERVICES IN OHIO. ADDITIONALLY, AFG WILL OFFER DARK FIBER SERVICES TO OTHER CLECs, IXC’s, ISPs AND BUSINESS AND ENTERPRISE CUSTOMERS.

“AFG” WILL PROVISION TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES THROUGH A COMBINATION OF ITS OWN FACILITIES AND FACILITIES LEASED FROM INCUMBENT LOCAL EXCHANGE CARRIERS (ILECs) AND RESALE OF SERVICES UTILIZING FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT OF ILECs OPERATING IN OHIO.

FACILITIES-BASED COMPETITIVE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE WILL BE PROVIDED VIA: (1) COMMERCIAL WHOLESALE AGREEMENTS WITH ILECs, (2) AFG’S OWN FACILITIES, OR (3) A COMBINATION THEREOF. INITIALLY, AFG INTENDS TO PROVIDE COMPETITIVE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE IN AREAS SERVED BY A T & T-OHIO, BUT DOES NOT INTEND TO PROVIDE SERVICES IN AREAS OF ANY SMALL OR RURAL LECs.
