Now comes, Denise Hasbrook, of legal age and after having been duly sworn and states that the following is true:

- 1. I am counsel for The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company in the above-referenced litigation filed by Complainant, American Wire and Cable Company.
- 2. On August 9, 2013, a First Set of Interrogatories and Request for Production of Documents were served upon Complainant seeking basic information on the claims and alleged damages asserted in the Complaint.
- 3. The responses were not timely received on August 30, 2013 when due. The responses to discovery are necessary in order for Respondent to fully prepare for the upcoming pretrial settlement conference which has been rescheduled to October 29, 2013 at 1:00 p.m.
