The attorney examiner finds:

- On January 4, 2005, the Commission issued Certificate No. 01-045 to the city of Maumee (Maumee) to provide governmental aggregator electric service. The expiration date for Certificate 01-045 is January 1, 2007.
- (2) On December 7, 2006, Maumee filed a motion for an extension of the expiration date of its existing certificate. In its motion, Maumee stated that, as a result of an inadvertent oversight, it failed to file its renewal application within the time frame set forth in Rule 4901:1-27-09(A), Ohio Administrative Code. Maumee notes that there have been no material changes in its application and it requests that, in order to continue providing service to its customers, that the expiration date of its certificate be extended while the Commission reviews its renewal application.
- (3) The examiner believes that an extension of the expiration date of Certificate No. 01-045 to January 13, 2007, is warranted so that Maumee's customers will not be adversely affected while its renewal application is under consideration.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That Maumee's motion for an extension of the certificate expiration date be granted. It is, further

ORDERED, That the January 1, 2007 expiration date of Certificate No. 01-045 be extended to January 13, 2007. It is, further,
