

THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION OF OHIO

## ENTRY

- (1) By entry issued November 27, 2006, the procedural schedule was established in this case wherein, among other things, intervenor testimony is due by January 5, 2007.
- (2) On December 15, 2006, the Office of the Ohio Consumers' Counsel (OCC) filed a motion for an extension of time to file intervenor testimony and a request for an expedited ruling. OCC states that depositions of Columbus Southern Power Company and Ohio Power Company (jointly AEP-Ohio) personnel are scheduled for the week of January 8, 2007. For these reasons, OCC requests that the due date for intervenor testimony be extended to January 19, 2007. Pursuant to Rule 4901-1-12(C), Ohio Administrative Code, OCC certifies that it has contacted all the parties to this proceeding and none of the parties object to the issuance of an expedited ruling on OCC's request for an extension of time to file intervenor testimony.
- (3) OCC's request for an extension of time to file intervenor testimony is reasonable and should be granted. Accordingly, the procedural schedule shall be revised and is established as follows:
  - (a) Intervenor testimony shall be filed by January 19, 2007.
  - (b) Staff testimony shall be filed by February 14, 2007.
  - (c) Evidentiary hearing to commence on February 27, 2007, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the

Commission, Room 11-C, 180 E. Broad St.,  
Columbus, Ohio.

- (4) The schedule for the six public hearings is not affected by the revisions to the procedural schedule and shall be held as previously set forth in the entry issued November 27, 2006.

It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That OCC's request for an extension of time to file intervenor testimony is granted. Accordingly, the procedural schedule is revised and established as set forth in finding 4. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this entry be served all interested persons of record in this docket.
