## **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) By entry dated October 11, 2006, the Commission directed its gas pipeline safety staff (Staff) to continue its investigation into the compliance of Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc., (Columbia) with Chapter with Chapter 4901:1-16, Ohio Administrative Code, and to file an investigative report within 90 days of the date of the entry.
- (2) On January 8, 2007, Staff filed a motion for extension time to file its report. Staff states that the parties have engaged in ongoing discussions concerning a settlement of this matter and need an additional 30 days continue such discussions. Further, Staff states that the extension will not jeopardize the safety of customers or citizens. Finally, Staff notes that Columbia does not object to the extension.
- (3) The attorney examiner finds that the motion for extension of time should be granted.

ORDERED, That the Staff's motion for extension of time be granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the Staff file an investigative report within 30 days of the date of this Entry and serve a copy of that report upon Columbia and all other parties of record. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record.
