Revised tariff sheets have been filed with the FCC to amend Verizon Tariff FCC No. 14, Facilities for Interstate Access, in which Verizon North Inc. concurs for intrastate applications.

Transmittal No. 765 – Effective January 26, 2007

With this transmittal, issued under authority of Special Permission No. 07-001 of the FCC, Verizon is introducing a new contract tariff option that provides discounted monthly rates for certain ports that allow DS1 services, DS3 services and multiplexed DS3 services to be connected to dedicated SONET rings that are provided by Verizon.


The actual filing documents may be viewed on the FCC's Internet website – www.fcc.gov – by doing the following:

1. On the FCC's main page www.fcc.gov at the top of the page, next to the FCC login, you will find a horizontal list of options. Click on E-Filing.
2. On the next page, scroll down until you see the paragraph on the Electronic Tariff Filing Systems (ETFS) and click on Electronic Tariff Filing System ETFS.
3. On the next page, scroll down to the bottom of the page and click on "Public Access" block.
4. On the next page, click on the "Browse Filed Tariff Documents" block.
5. On the next page, click on the "Browse Documents Filed by an ILEC" block.
6. On the next page, click on "Verizon Telephone Companies."
7. On the next page, click on "FCC14". However, before moving to the next page, you may want to bookmark this page in order to skip Steps 1-6 in the future.
8. On the next page, you will be shown a table of the filings that have been made for that tariff number starting with the most recent. Click on the part of the filing you want to view under the heading "View PDF". Each filing may have several parts, so look for the transmittal number on each line.

With this transmittal, issued under authority of Special Permission No. 07-001 of the Federal Communications Commission, Verizon is introducing a new contract tariff option that provides discounted monthly rates for certain ports that allow DS1 services, DS3 services and multiplexed DS3 services to be connected to dedicated Synchronous Optical NETwork (SONET) rings that are provided by Verizon. Additionally for Tariff F.C.C. No. 11, this contract tariff option provides discounted monthly rates for DS1 services, DS3 services and multiplexed DS3 services that are served by Verizon New York wire centers that are within the New York, NY

Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA). The customer must meet the eligibility requirements and satisfy other requirements that are described in the attached tariff pages in order to be eligible for the discounted monthly rates of this option. This option is filed as Contract Tariff Option 45 in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Contract Tariff Option 46 in Tariff F.C.C. No. 11, and Contract Tariff Option 21 in Tariff F.C.C. No. 14.

Revisions to these options are filed pursuant to Verizon receiving Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in qualifying MSAs.

Supporting material under Section 61.49 is not required with this filing. However, a document with a detailed explanation of the filing is being provided as an attachment hereto.


This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
