
**MOTION OF COLUMBUS SOUTHERN POWER COMPANY FOR WAIVER OF

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
MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

This project involves a 138kV line relocation of approximately 1.21 miles in length. On December 20, 2006, AEP filed a Letter of Notification ("LON") regarding the project (Case No. 06-1489-EL-BLN). The project is also related to a re-conductoring project which was filed separately as a construction notice on the same date (Case No. 06-1488-EL-BNR). Subsequently, at the request of the Village of Obetz, AEP agreed to modify the route. AEP had planned to implement these projects in tandem and had filed the 06-1489 case in anticipation of commencing construction on March 20, 2007. Notwithstanding its accommodation to the Village of Obetz, AEP would like to keep the original schedule and implement the projects in tandem. AEP requests, therefore, that the Board find that good causes exists to waive the 90-day filing requirement and permit the company to begin construction of the instant project March 20, 2007.
