By its application in the above-referenced dockets of November 6, 2006, Dominion Field Services, Inc. ("DFS") sought authority from this Commission pursuant to Rule 4901:1-27-11(B), Ohio Administrative Code, to abandon Certificate No. 02-044(2) and cease operations as a certified supplier of competitive retail natural gas service ("CRNGS") in this state.

Rule 4901:1-27-11(B)(3), Ohio Administrative Code, provides that, if the Commission does not act upon an abandonment application within ninety days of filing, the application is deemed to be automatically approved effective on the ninety-first date from the filing date. Because the Commission did not act on DFS's application within the specified period, the application has been deemed to be automatically approved.
