The attorney examiner finds:

- On February 3, 2005, the Commission issued Certificate No. 00-032 to the city of Northwood (Northwood) to provide governmental aggregation service. The expiration date for Certificate 00-032 was January 20, 2007.
- (2) On February 12, 2007, Northwood filed a motion for an extension of the expiration date of its existing certificate. In its motion, Northwood stated that it inadvertently failed to file an application for renewal of its certificate within the timeframe set forth in Rule 4901:1-27-09(A), Ohio Administrative Code. Northwood indicated that there have been no material changes in the operation of its aggregation program and the extension of the certificate expiration date is necessary to prevent irreparable harm to Northwood and its aggregation participants.
- (3) The examiner believes that an extension of the expiration date of Certificate No. 00-032 to March 20, 2007, is warranted so that Northwood's customers will not be adversely affected while its renewal application is under consideration.
