



## EXHIBIT C – DESCRIPTION OF REVISIONS

This filing is being made to make the following three revisions to the Cincinnati Bell Any Distance tariff.

1. Grandfather business Product 667. Current subscribers will keep this product but there will be no new sales of this product.
2. Add business Product 105, which will be sold with Cincinnati Bells complete connections service. This product provides customers with 1000 minutes of outbound long distance per month. A per minute rate of \$.06 applies after the initial 1000 minutes.
3. As of February 23, 2007 new residential and business customers subscribing to a toll plan will no longer receive a waiver of the monthly service fee associated with the first 8XX number.
