	<u>ENTRY</u>

The Commission finds:

- (1) On November 9, 2006, Enrique Bello (the complainant) filed a formal complaint in this case against the respondent, United Telephone Company of Ohio d/b/a Embarq (Embarq). The complaint alleged that the respondent has imposed arbitrary charges and made unauthorized changes to the promised services which the complainant originally requested from the respondent.
- (2) On November 28, 2006, the respondent filed a motion seeking an extension of time, until December 6, 2006, for filing its answer to the complaint. This motion was granted by an attorney examiner's entry issued in this case on December 1, 2006. On December 6, 2006, the respondent filed a motion seeking an additional extension of time, until December 15, 2006, for filing its answer to the complaint. In this motion for a second extension for filing its answer, the respondent submitted that the parties were working together to resolve the complaint, but that additional time would be required for Embarq to respond to all of the complainant's questions.
- (3) On December 15, 2006, the respondent filed a motion for dismissal of the complaint, based on the fact that the parties had resolved the complaint. Attached to the motion for dismissal was a signed statement of the complainant which authorized the respondent to file the motion to dismiss on the complainant's behalf.
