In re: Geauga County 138 kV Transmission Line, Case No 07-0171-EL-BTX

Dear Sirs:

The proposed CEI 138 kV Transmission Line proposed route along Clay Street in Geauga County will affect me as follows:

- 1. It will remove a house I own.
- 2. It will cause devastation over the ¾ mile on property I own.
- 3. It will put me out of business in a business I have established over 42 years in a metal fabricating shop. This business is forty feet from the right of way and will be eliminated.
- 4. It will damage extensive fencing for my pasture and crop land that will be destroyed along my ¾ of a mile frontage.

I suggest two potential resolutions:

- Add the second 36 kV to the existing poles.
- 2. Put the line behind the structures on properties so as not to visually and aesthetically damage Clay Street, Geauga County. (If you travel from Route 87 north on Route 528 you can visually see the unbelievable impairment of the county. It looks ugly.) It seems there is no reason to intentionally make something ugly when it can be placed elsewhere.

You can see that I am very concerned over this project and I hope you will seriously reconsider its' impact on my property and Geauga County.
