### Statement of Proposal

The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (the "Company") proposes to grandfather Tariff Sheet Nos. 41 & 42 as of June 1, 2007. The referenced Tariff Sheets are the Company's Outdoor Lighting and Outdoor Night Lighting schedules (collectively, "Private Outdoor Lighting" or "POL") and apply to outdoor area and security lighting service on private property. Service under these rate schedules is supplied in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Company and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio.

By grandfathering these schedules on June 1, 2007, these schedules will be closed to new customers as of that date. Any customers taking service on either of these schedules as of June 1, 2007 can continue taking service under the POL schedules.

Once the POL schedules are grandfathered, customers can continue to utilize non-utility alternatives that are currently available in the marketplace. For example, customers will have opportunities to buy and install competitively priced outdoor lighting and receive metered electric service from the Company through existing metering configurations. Additionally, customers will be able to hire private contractors to install outdoor lighting and receive metered electric service from the Company.

Therefore, the Company is hereby requesting authority to, beginning June 1, 2007, grand-father the POL schedules such that new customers may not take service under these schedules.
