## **ENTRY**

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On April 17, 2005, the Commission issued Certificate No. 05-098(1) to EnergyWindow, Inc. (EnergyWindow), to provide retail natural gas broker and gas aggregation service. The expiration date for Certificate 05-098(1) is April 17, 2007.
- On March 20, 2007, EnergyWindow filed a renewal application and a motion for an extension of the expiration date of its existing certificate. In its motion, EnergyWindow stated that, as a result of an inadvertent oversight, it failed to file its renewal application within the time frame set forth in Rule 4901:1-27-09(A), Ohio Administrative Code. EnergyWindow also stated that there have been no material changes in its operations. EnergyWindow requests that the Commission extend the expiration date of its certificate from April 17, 2007, to April 20, 2007.
- (3) The examiner believes that an extension of the expiration date of Certificate No. 05-098(1) to April 20, 2007, is warranted, so that EnergyWindow's customers will not be adversely affected while its renewal application is under consideration.
