## **ENTRY**

## The Commission finds:

- (1) On December 26, 2006, Mark Riegel/Riegel Farms LLC, (complainant) filed a complaint against Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc., (Columbia) alleging that there is a problem with the amount Columbia charged for gas usage in January and February 2006, and requesting that the Commission review the amount of gas used in those months compared to previous years.
- (2) On January 16, 2007, Columbia filed an answer denying the allegations of the complaint.
- (3) On March 2, 2007, a settlement conference was held in accordance with the attorney examiner entry issued February 14, 2007.
- (4) On March 23, 2007, Columbia filed a motion to dismiss stating that the parties have reached an agreement in this matter. Therefore, in accordance with Rule 4901-9-01, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), Columbia states this case should be dismissed if the complainant does not file a written response within 20 days.
- (5) Rule 4901-9-01(E), O.A.C., provides that, when a public utility files a motion stating that the case has been settled, the complainant shall file a response within 20 days. If no response is filed, the Commission may presume that settlement has occurred and may dismiss the complaint.
