FINDING AND ORDER

The Commission finds:

- (1) On March 23, 2007, AT&T Ohio (AT&T or applicant) filed an application seeking to add an exception for AT&T Volume Discount Plan offering contained in its Tariff P.U.C.O. No. 20.
- (2) The exception proposed by AT&T is to its interstate Special Access Services Tariff, F.C.C. No. 2. AT&T filed a revision to its F.C.C. No. 2 to add a new Section 28 which contains the newly created AT&T Volume Discount Plan (ADVP). ADVP was established to comply with AT&T's Merger Commitment #9 made to the Federal Communications Commission in the AT&T/Bell South merger proceeding. Pursuant to this commitment, AT&T has filed interstate tariffs making the discount plan available for certain interstate services. This filing is being made to clarify that this discount plan will not be available on an intrastate basis in Ohio.
- (3) After a thorough review of AT&T's application, we find that the application does not appear to be unreasonable and should be granted.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That AT&T's application is granted as discussed in finding 3. It is, further,

ORDERED, That AT&T is authorized to file complete copies of tariffs in final form consistent with this finding and order. Applicant shall file one copy in its TRF docket (or may make such filing electronically as described in Case No. 06-900-AU-WVR), and one copy in this case docket. It is, further,

ORDERED, That the effective date of the new tariffs shall be a date not earlier than both the date of this finding and order and the date upon which complete copies of final



tariffs are filed with the Commission. The new tariffs shall be effective for services rendered on or after such effective date. It is, further,

ORDERED, That nothing in this finding and order shall be binding upon this Commission in any subsequent investigation or proceeding involving the justness or reasonableness of any rate, charge, rule, or regulation. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this finding and order be served upon AT&T Ohio.


