2. DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL:

Aqua Ohio, Inc. (herein "Company" or "Aqua Ohio") proposes to amend Masury Division Master Tariff, P.U.C.O. No. 4. Aqua Ohio proposed to amend the Masury Tariff in three ways:


1. Change the billing period from bi-monthly to monthly. This change in the billing period from bi-monthly to monthly shall not have any effect on the rates charged or the revenues of the Company;

2. Change the cubic feet measurement from being in 100 cubic feet increments to 10 cubic feet increments. This change simply results in the decimal place in the rate pages moving one place to the left; and
 3. Add a conversion that converts the rates for cubic feet measurements into gallon measurements for those customers that have water meters that measure in gallons as opposed to cubic feet. This is not intended to be a new rate nor is the rate in gallons intended to permit recovery of revenue greater than what was authorized in the last Masury Division rate case.
3. Attached hereto and incorporated by reference herein are the current Tariff Pages for Masury Division Master Tariff P.U.C.O. 4, Section 2, Rates as well as the proposed Tariff pages:
 - (A) Exhibit A – Masury Division, Master Tariff, P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 4, existing tariff section 2, Fourth Revised Sheet 1 replacing Third Revised Sheet 1.
 - (B) Exhibit B – Masury Division, Master Tariff, P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 4, proposed new tariff section 2, Fifth Revised Sheet 1 replacing Fourth Revised Sheet 1.
4. Also attached hereto and incorporated as Exhibit C is a proposed revised Subject Index Page. In addition, attached hereto and incorporated as Exhibit D is a proposed notice to be mailed to customers explaining the approved changes to be mailed to customers upon approval of the application.
5. This application will not result in an increase in any rate, joint rate, toll, classification, charge or rental.
6. Applicant Aqua Ohio respectfully requests the Commission to permit the filing of the proposed tariff sheets, to become effective on the date, subsequent to filing, to be shown

on the proposed tariff sheets which will be filed with the Commission; and to be in the form of the tariff sheet in Exhibit B, modified by any further revisions that have become effective prior to the effective date of the proposed schedule sheets.

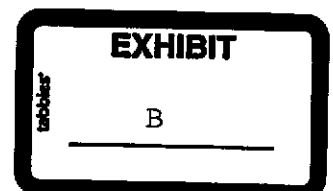

Proposed Notice to Masury Customers of Change in Tariff

On ____, 2007, in case No. 07-____-WW-ATA, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio approved a request by Aqua Ohio, Inc., to make changes to the rate pages of the Masury Division P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 4. The approval changes the billing cycle from bi-monthly to monthly, changes the measurement of water usage from 100 cubic feet to 10 cubic feet and permits the calculation of the water usage in gallons as well as cubic feet. You will see these changes reflected on your next water bill. These changes to the tariff do not have any impact on the rates charged by Aqua Ohio to the customers of the Masury Division or your typical water bill.
