The grocery stores operated by Kroger are high load factor facilities that use energy for food storage, lighting, heating, cooling and distribution, often on a 24 hour a day, 7 day a week basis. Therefore, the interests of Kroger may be directly affected by the outcome of this proceeding. The interests of Kroger cannot be adequately represented by any other party. Kroger intends to play a constructive role in this case and provide information which will assist the Commission.

No other party to this proceeding can adequately represent Kroger's interest. Intervention would not unduly delay the proceeding nor unjustly prejudice any existing party.
