TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("R.C.") Section 4903.22.1 and Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Rule 4901-1-11, PP&L EnergyPlus Co., LLC ("EnergyPlus"), hereby moves to intervene in this proceeding.
