## MOTION OF EXELON ENERGY TO INTERVENE

Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("R.C.") Section 4903.22.1 and Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Rule 4901-1-11, Exelon Energy ("Exelon"), hereby moves to intervene in this proceeding. The Public Utilities Commission of Ohio ("Commission") should grant Exelon leave to intervene because Exelon has a real and substantial interest in the proceeding, and the Commission's disposition of this proceeding will affect Exelon's ability to protect its interests.
