- (1) On March 20, 2007, Barbara Caswell (complainant) filed a complaint against The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (CEI) alleging that she has lost power for significant amounts of time and requesting that she receive the same level of uninterrupted electrical service as her neighbors.
- (2) By entry issued April 27, 2007, the attorney examiner scheduled this matter for settlement conference. At the request of the parties, the settlement conference was postponed.
- (3) On June 19, 2007, the complainant and CEI filed a joint motion to dismiss this case with prejudice stating that the parties have settled this matter and resolved all of the issues raised in the complaint.
- (4) In light of the resolution of the complaint, this case should be dismissed.
