Revised tariff sheets have been filed with the FCC to amend Verizon Tariff FCC No. 14, Facilities for Interstate Access, in which Verizon North Inc. concurs for intrastate applications.

<u>Transmittal No. 826</u> – Effective July 24, 2007 With this transmittal, Verizon is revising FCC No. 14 to introduce a new contract tariff option (Contract Option). This new Contract Option will provide a customer with billing credits and other benefits on certain Special Access Services when the customer maintains a minimum in total billed revenue for the services included in the Contract Option and meets other criteria as specified.
