ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On June 27, 2007, AT&T Ohio (AT&T) filed a complaint against United Telephone Company of Ohio dba Embarq (Embarq) seeking a declaratory ruling to determine whether Embarq is demanding unlawful and unreasonable charges for service. The charges relate to a telecommunications service agreement with the State of Ohio and a supporting subcontractor agreement between AT&T and Embarq.
- (2) On July 6, 2007, Embarq filed a motion requesting that it be granted until August 4, 2007, to move or plead. Embarq requests an extension of time to sort through the complexity of the matters raised in the complaint. Embarq notes that it has consulted with counsel for AT&T and that AT&T does not object to the requested extension.
- (3) Taking into consideration that there is no undue delay, prejudice to any party, or objection from AT&T, the motion to extend the time for responding to the complaint is reasonable and should be granted. The time to respond to the complaint shall be extended to Monday, August 6, 2007.


It is, therefore,


ORDERED, That Embarq's motion to extend time is granted. Embarq shall file an answer and other appropriate pleadings on or before August 6, 2007. It is further
