ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On January 29, 2007, Steven Carp (Dr. Carp or complainant) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T). In his complaint, Dr. Carp alleged that AT&T double billed for Yellow Page advertising.
- (2) On February 20, 2007, AT&T filed an Answer and a Motion to Dismiss. AT&T moved to dismiss the complaint, asserting that the Commission lacks subject matter jurisdiction over Yellow Page advertising.
- (3) By entry issued April 4, 2007, the Commission granted AT&T's motion and dismissed the complainant's Yellow Page advertising claims for lack of jurisdiction.
- (4) In addition to dismissing the Yellow Page advertising claims, the entry granted the complainant 20 days to file a statement clarifying whether any claims in the complaint relate to matters other than Yellow Page advertising. The Commission advised the complainant that it would dismiss the complaint in its entirety if the complainant failed to file a clarifying statement within 20 days of the entry. To date, the complainant has not filed a clarifying statement. In accordance with the April 4, 2007, entry, the Commission shall assume that the complaint relates entirely to Yellow Page advertising and, therefore, shall dismiss the complaint in its entirety.

It is, therefore,

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ORDERED, That, in accordance with Finding (4), the complaint is dismissed in its entirety. It is, further,

ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties, counsel, and all interested persons of record.
