On July 18, 2007, tariff pages for the Ameritech Operating Companies were filed with the Federal Communications Commission under Transmittal No. 1633. This filing in the FCC No. 2 Tariff became effective on August 2, 2007.

With this filing, Ameritech is proposing to introduce the new Unprotected Channel Transport (UCT) feature for Dedicated SONET Ring Service. Additionally, this filing proposes to clarify existing rules and regulations as they relate to the Optical-to-Electrical Add/Drop Capability feature for Dedicated SONET Ring Services. This filing includes the following revisions: 1) Adding a change in regulation as it relates to the OC-192 Add/Drop Capability charge not being applied to CO nodes without drop ports. This was also added as a footnote to the OC-192 rate section, where applicable. 2) Making text changes and removing erroneous information from the OC-192 Optical-to-Electrical Add/Drop Capability text description. Additionally, erroneous upgrade material that does not pertain to this section is being removed. 3) Adding the footnote, "An OC-3 port charge is needed with each Optical-to-Electrical Add/Drop Capability-Per OC-3 to DS-1 Add/Drop." This footnote was added to Section 7, page 418.1.2.3 on 10/02/06, effective 10/17/06, but was inadvertently left out of Section 21, page 805.1. None of the revisions included in this filing adversely affect existing customers.

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules, to the extent applicable, is included with this filing in the attached Description and Justification.


