With this transmittal, Verizon hereby submits tariff pages to make revisions to Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1, 11, and 14. The revisions provide for the addition of pricing flexibility rate elements for certain services that Verizon introduced since last updating its pricing flexibility rate elements under Transmittal No. 716 effective on July 18, 2006. Verizon makes this filing pursuant to

receiving Pricing Flexibility in specific Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs)¹. The services for which pricing flexibility rate elements are introduced were filed as new price cap services when they were initially introduced. The filings that introduced each of these new services included an attachment titled Figure 1 that identified the price cap basket and service category into which the new service would ultimately be incorporated. Verizon has since demonstrated in its 2007 Annual Access Tariff Filing² that these services should be granted the same Phase I or Phase II regulatory relief in the MSAs and non-MSAs where the service category has been granted such relief.

Support material as described under Section 61.49 of Commission's Rules is not required with this filing. However, attached to this filing is Figure 1, which illustrates the services for which pricing flexibility rates are being introduced. For each service included in this filing, Figure 1 lists the specific annual filing in which Verizon demonstrated that the new service should be granted Phase I and Phase II regulatory relief, the transmittal number under which the service was introduced, and the price cap service category into which the service was added.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).

Payment in the amount of \$775.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS.
