Dear Ms. Jenkins:

AT&T Ohio (which is the name under which The Ohio Bell Telephone Company does business) (the "Company") hereby files revised maps of both its Canton and North Canton exchanges, without application, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code § 4901:1-3-03(F). Reduced copies of the revised maps, size 8½" x 11", reflecting the proposed boundary changes are also attached. Both this letter and the reduced maps are being filed in duplicate pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code § 4901:1-3-03(G).

The revised maps reflect the incorporation of portions of AT&T Ohio's Canton Exchange into its North Canton Exchange. The Company provides the following reason for making this change:

Land is being cleared and lots are being staked for a new residential development (The Hermitage). The majority of this development is currently located in the North Canton Exchange while some is located within the Canton exchange. The requested change will increase the area served by the North Canton Exchange and decrease the area served by the Canton Exchange.

With this change, the entire development will be fed with fiber to the premise. In addition to economic benefits, the boundary change will include all of The Hermitage development in the North Canton Exchange and will serve the new development with AT&T's newest fiber technologies (FTTP).

The North Canton boundary will need to be moved south to C/L on Everhard Rd NW from 650' east of Brunnerdale Ave. NW to 100' northeast of Wakerly Dr. NW as follows:

At 980' east of C/L Brunnerdale Av. NW, the boundary will be moved south approximately 120' to C/L Marzilli Cir. NW. At 825' east of Brunnerdale Av NW. It is also moved south approximately 440' and 650' east of C/L Brunnerdale Av. and south 740' to C/L Everhard Rd. NW. At 100' northeast of C/L Wakerly Dr NW, the boundary was also moved southeast 100' to C/L Everhard Rd NW.


The changes are found on the Southwest corner of the North Canton Exchange and the Northwest Corner of the Canton Exchange.

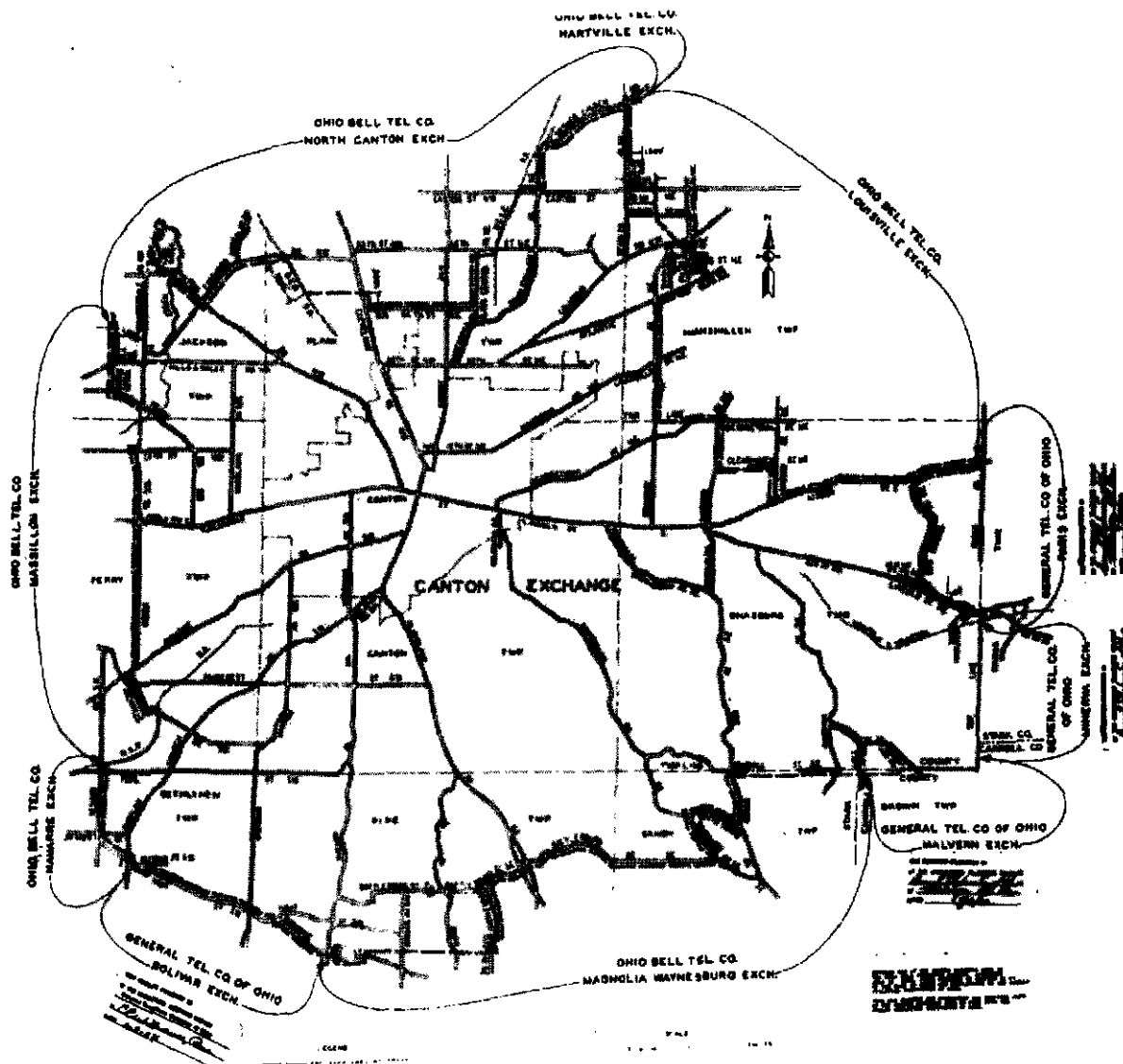

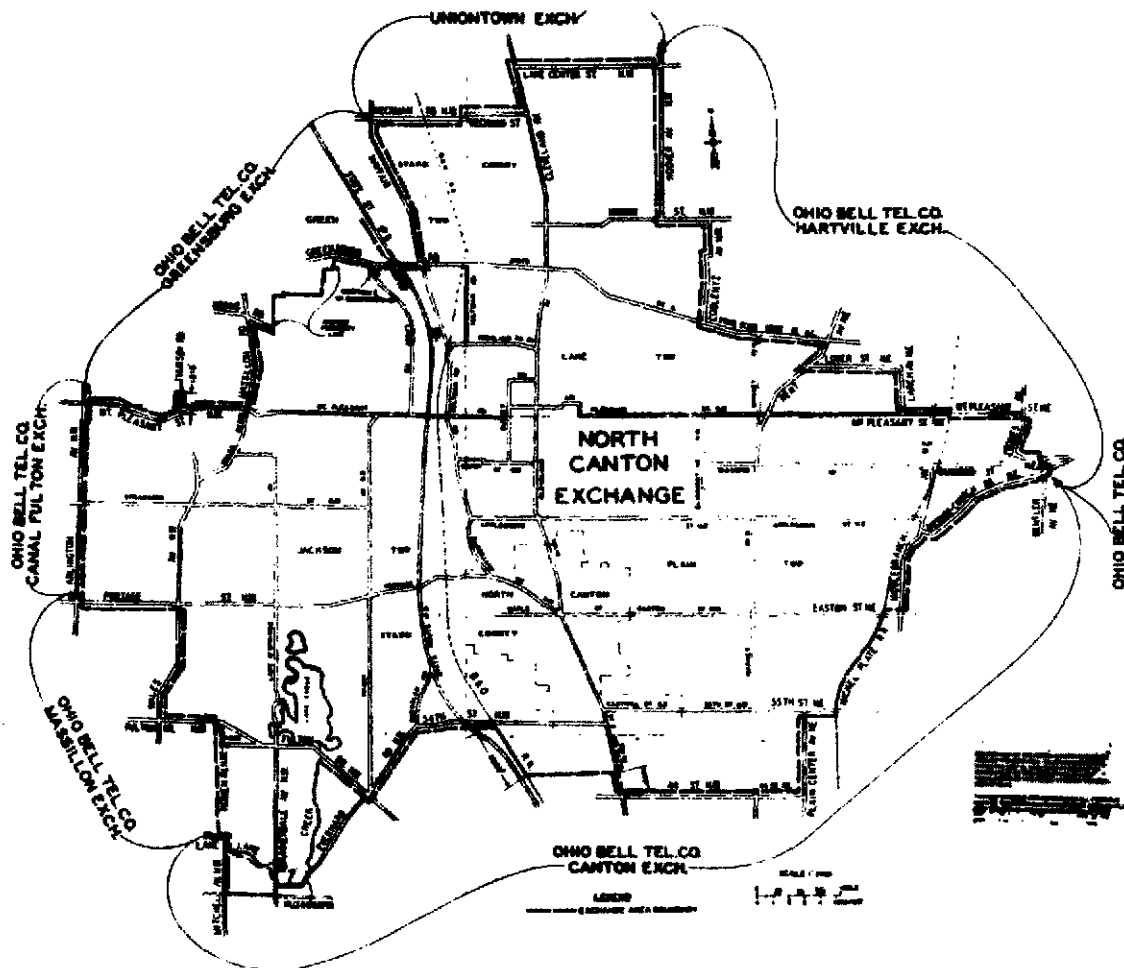
