ENTRY

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On August 29, 2005, Friends of the Homeless, Inc., (FOH) filed a complaint against McLeodUSA Telecommunications Services, Inc. (McLeodUSA). FOH alleged in the complaint that McLeodUSA has failed to furnish necessary and adequate services, and FOH requests that the Commission direct that repairs, improvements or additions be made by McLeodUSA within a reasonable time.
- (2) On September 20, 2005, McLeodUSA filed its answer, variously admitting and denying the allegations contained in the complaint.
- (3) The evidentiary hearing in this case is scheduled for August 30, 2007. However, the parties have been engaged in active efforts to resolve this case and hope to resolve this matter soon.
- (4) Accordingly, the attorney examiner finds that this case should be continued indefinitely. If necessary, a new hearing date will be scheduled by subsequent entry.

ORDERED, That the hearing in this proceeding be continued indefinitely. It is, further,


