MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services ("Verizon Business") is filing with your office an original and three (3) copies of revisions to its P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 2.

Verizon Business proposes the following revisions and respectfully requests an effective date of September 1, 2007.

1) Increase the monthly minimum charge associated with the following Option GG, Advanced Option II for Small Business Savings Plans: III, VIII, IX, X, XII, XIII, and XIV.
2) Increase the monthly recurring charges associated with the following residential service offerings: Option LLL (Integrated Calling Plan R3), Option MMM (Integrated Calling Plan RB), Option NNN (Integrated Calling Plan RC), Option OOO (Integrated Calling Plan RD), and Option MMMM (Integrated RLE Service).
3) Increase the Option PPPP (Business B2 Integrated Service) Offering $C$ and Block-of-Time Offering 1 monthly recurring charges for primary and additional lines.

Affected customers were notified of the rate increases via an invoice message.
