- (1) On March 5, 2007, Dawan Clayborne (Mr. Clayborne, complainant) filed a complaint with the Commission against Columbia Gas of Ohio, Inc. (Columbia). In the complaint, Mr. Clayborne alleged that Columbia improperly charged him for gas service.
- (2) On May 31, 2007, a settlement conference was held in an attempt to informally resolve this matter. The parties, however, were unable to reach a resolution of the issues presented in the complaint. Further, it appears that reasonable grounds for complaint have been presented.
- (3) Accordingly, a hearing in this matter should be scheduled to begin at 10:00 a.m. on October 30, 2007, in the offices of the Commission, hearing room 11-G, 180 E. Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio.
- (4) In Commission proceedings, the complainant has the burden of proving the allegations in the complaint. Thus, at hearing, it shall be the complainant's responsibility to appear and be prepared to present evidence in support of the complaint.
