ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) On April 3, 2007, the Cincinnati Insurance Company (CIC), as subrogee of Michael J. and Rhonda J. Francis (Complainants) filed a complaint against The Toledo Edison Company (Toledo Edison), requesting a monetary judgment for damages to Complainants' property. CIC alleged that Toledo Edison, in error, turned off power to Complainants' property, causing water lines to freeze and break.
- (2) On April 25, 2007, Toledo Edison answered the complaint by stating that it had received a request to disconnect service from a resident at Complainants' property. Toledo Edison denied any other allegations of CIC.
- (3) A prehearing conference was conducted on July 9, 2007, at the Commission offices.
- (4) On August 29, 2007, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the complaint. The joint motion stated that the parties have reached a resolution of the matter that fully resolves all issues in the proceeding. The parties also request that the Commission dismiss the proceeding with prejudice.
- (5) In light of the parties' joint motion to dismiss, the Commission shall dismiss this complaint with prejudice.
