Revised tariff sheets have been filed with the FCC to amend Verizon Tariff FCC No. 14, Facilities for Interstate Access, in which Verizon North Inc. concurs for intrastate applications.

<u>Transmittal No. 859</u> – Effective September 29, 2007 With this transmittal, Verizon is revising FCC No. 14 to amend the tariff for its specialized arrangement with the General Services Administration. The arrangement known as Washington Interagency Telecommunications Systems 2001 was originally established in July 2000 with an eight-year term; this filing provides rates for year eight of the commitment period.
