With this transmittal, Verizon hereby submits tariff pages to make rate increases to reflect the changes in TRS exogenous costs as a result of the recent F.C.C. Order<sup>2</sup> regarding TRS factors. In addition to the rate changes, Verizon has changed the Price Cap indices to reflect the change in TRS exogenous costs.

Additionally, the maximum reduction for Lifeline Assistance to the primary residence end user common line charge, as described in Section 4.2(B) of Tariff F.C.C. No. 16, is modified to reflect that such reduction may be up to \$6.50 (i.e., the highest rate for a primary residence end user common line charge in any of the jurisdictions of this tariff).

Support material as described under Section 61.49 of Commission's Rules is included with this filing.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
