The Wabash Mutual Telephone Company hereby provides notice that it will begin waiving the Service Order Charge and Central Office Connection Charge for new business and residential customers who maintain their basic local exchange service for one year. Such charges will be waived upon activation of new service. If the customer disconnects service within one year, the Company will add these charges to the Customer's final bill.
