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MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

The OCC requests a subpoena, pursuant to Ohio Adm. Code 4901-1-25(A), to command Gary J. Hebbeler, General Manager of Gas Engineering for Duke, to appear for the hearing and attend day-to-day to submit to oral examination as on cross-examination by OCC in this proceeding until completed. The hearing in this case is currently scheduled to begin on October 29, 2007, and will take place in PUCO hearing room 11-C, eleventh floor, 180 E. Broad St., Columbus, Ohio 43215.

Gary J. Hebbeler, General Manager of Gas Engineering for Duke Energy Ohio, Inc. ("Duke") would be called for the purpose of addressing the following items:

- 1. The Perfection Servi-Sert Interchange Head partial replacement process being used by Duke to replace prone to leak natural gas risers:
- The cost difference between the Perfection Servi-Sert Interchange
 Head partial replacement process and the full replacement process
 being used by Duke to replace prone to leak natural gas risers;
- 3. The circumstances under which the Perfection Servi-Sert Interchange Head partial replacement process was developed and under what circumstances it can be used:

- 4. Duke's experiences using the Perfection Servi-Sert Interchange Head partial replacement process;
- 5. Duke's explanation of the reasonableness of its current 27 year plan to replace prone to leak natural gas risers, and its proposed 9 year plan to replace prone to leak natural gas risers.
