The appropriate Shopping Credit Adder Rider amounts from Case No. 07-1003-EL-ATA to be effective on January 1, 2008, would be:





Reason for Proposal

(Shopping Credit Adder Revision)

Per the provisions of the Rate Certainty Plan (RCP) approved by the Commission in an Opinion and Order in Case No. 05-1125-EL-ATA, dated January 4, 2006, Ohio Edison and Toledo Edison must annually submit a revised Shopping Credit Adder Rider based on fuel costs during the immediately prior year. Similarly, Cleveland Electric Illuminating (CEI) must annually submit a revised Shopping Credit Adder Rider based on fuel deferrals booked for CEI during the immediately prior year. (See paragraph 7 of the Stipulation and Recommendation in Case No. 05-1125-EL-ATA for the support for making these annual revisions to the Shopping Credit Adder Riders.) This proposal recommends the values for the revised Shopping Credit Adder Riders for 2008.

Calculation of Rate Amounts

As discussed in the Description of Proposal section, the Companies will implement the revised Shopping Credit Adder Riders approved by the Commission in Case No. 07-1003-EL-ATA et seq., presuming an Order is issued in that proceeding prior to January 1, 2008. In the circumstance where no such Order is issued before January 1, 2008, then the revised Shopping Credit Adder Rider for 2008 should be established at the levels set forth below. As calculated under the existing RCP Stipulation and Order, the applicable shopping credits for Ohio Edison and Toledo Edison during 2008 will be decreased to reflect the fuel costs during the immediately prior year based on that prior years' fuel costs (calculated by using nine months' actual and three months' projected fuel costs.) The applicable shopping credits for CEI for 2008 will be decreased to reflect the fuel deferrals for CEI booked during the immediately prior year based on that prior years' fuel deferrals (calculated by using nine months' actual and three months pro-

jected CEI fuel deferrals). These decreases in the Shopping Credits for 2008 will be included on the Shopping Credit Adder Rider tariff sheets and shall reflect the values shown below:
