Duke Energy Ohio has filed an application with the Ohio Power Siting Board in Case No. 07-812-ELseeking to amend a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need issued for the construction of an electric transmission line in Brown and Clermont counties. Ohio. purpose of the requested amendment is to relocate approximately 1,600 feet of the transmission line, shifting the route approximately 200 feet south of the approved centerline, located in Clermont County, near the southeast corner of Hagemans Crossing Road and the Norfolk and Western Railroad. More information may be obtained by contacting the offices of the Ohio Power Siting Board, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793 or by reviewing a copy of the amendment application at the main library in your area. Interested persons wishing to file objections to the proposed change may do so by filing written objections to the Ohio Power Siting Board with 10 days of this notice.
