Duke Energy Ohio has filed an application with the Ohio Power Siting Board in Case No. 07-812-EL-BTA seeking to amend a certificate of environmental compatibility and public need issued for the construction of an electric transmission line in Brown and Clermont counties, Ohio. The purpose of the requested amendment is to relocate approximately 1,600 feet of the transmission line, shifting the route approximately 200 feet south of the approved centerline, located in Clermont County, near the southeast corner of Hagemans Crossing Road and the Norfolk and Western Railroad.
