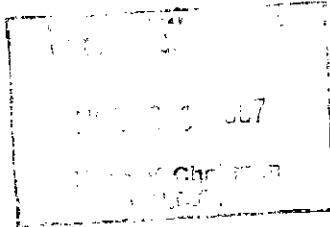

To Whom It May Concern:

We rent the property at 11933 Madison road. We want to voice our objections to, PUCO case# 07-0171-EL-BTX, the 38 K.V. transmission line project that is proposed to cut the property in half. The transmission line would require at least a sixty foot wide corridor consisting of cultivated land, woodlands, and wetlands. We want the land preserved so our sons have private secure land to play on. We have cleared a path so they can walk or ride their four-wheelers learning about nature, watching the wildlife, and be safe from the public. The proposed transmission corridor would open this private area to the public and all the machinery would scare the deer, turkeys and other wildlife.

We think there are other pre-existing corridors that would cause much less destruction. The Route 11 is a pre-existing corridor that would provide electricity for Geauga County and also to the south, where there is a need. The once approved Rachel Transmission corridor along the old B&O railroad is also a pre-existing corridor which could be used instead of going through virgin, unspoiled land.

We appreciate the opportunity to express our concern about the Geauga County 138 K.V. project. We hope that our concerns will be considered when decisions are being made.
