<u>ENTRY</u>

The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On September 18, 2007, Milling Away, LLC (Milling Away or Complainant) filed a complaint against Ohio Edison Company (Ohio Edison) alleging that Milling Away had been incorrectly billed for power usage at a prior address. The complaint provided no additional information.
- (2) Ohio Edison responded on November 2, 2007, by stating that it has provided electric service to Milling Away at various times in several locations and under several different accounts. Ohio Edison added that in light of this history and the brevity of the complaint, Ohio Edison could not determine with particularity the facts and circumstances underlying the complaint, and denied the allegations in the complaint. Finally, Ohio Edison states that it currently maintains an account in Complainant's name, which reflects charges for current electric service, plus a prior balance for which Milling Away had been responsible, and that the transfer of a balance from another account was done lawfully.
- (3) Having examined Milling Away's complaint and Ohio Edison's response, the attorney examiner concludes that a prehearing conference is appropriate. Therefore, this matter is scheduled for a prehearing conference on December 19, 2007, at 1:30 p.m. in Hearing Room 11-A of the Commission Offices, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The purpose of the prehearing conference is to resolve issues without the need to proceed to a hearing.
