1 1. Q. Please state your name and business address.

2 A. My name is Jill A. Henry. My business address is 180 East Broad Street,  
3 Columbus, Ohio, 43215.

4 2. Q. What is your current position?

5 A. I am employed by the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio as a Gas  
6 Pipeline Safety Investigator in the Gas Pipeline Safety Section, Facility and  
7 Operations Field Division, Service Monitoring and Enforcement  
8 Department.

9 3. Q. Please summarize your education and professional qualifications.

10 A. I am a graduate of the Ohio State University, where I obtained a Bachelor  
11 of Science degree in civil engineering. I also have completed 10 week long  
12 classes on pipeline safety at the Transportation Safety Institute in  
13 Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. I also completed the three Appalachian  
14 Underground Corrosion Short Courses offered at West Virginia University  
15 in Morgantown, West Virginia. I also have served as a National  
16 Association of Pipeline Safety Representatives (NAPSR) representative on  
17 the Gas Piping Technology Committee (GPTC) since March 2000, which is  
18 sponsored by the American Gas Association. I am also a member of the  
19 Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration, Gas Integrity  
20 Management Team which worked on developing the inspection materials,  
21 interpretations, and implementation of the gas integrity regulations.

22 4. Q. Please summarize your business experience.

1       A.    I have worked for the Public Utilities Commission since 1994 as a Gas  
2       Pipeline Safety Compliance Investigator in the Gas Pipeline Safety Section.  
3       My responsibilities include the inspection of gas company facilities, records  
4       and procedures for compliance with state and federal regulations. I prepare  
5       reports on these inspections, and, when applicable, prepare probable  
6       violation reports. My responsibilities have grown to include the  
7       coordination of gas pipeline safety staff reports, stipulation agreements, and  
8       stipulation monitoring. Additionally, I monitor the federal register and  
9       other publications for interpretations and changes to the gas pipeline safety  
10      regulations. I am the lead integrity management investigator for Ohio and  
11      have been involved in every phase of the riser investigation, Case No. 05-  
12      463-GA-COI.
