Dear Mr. Conrad;

Effective January 1, 2005, The Champaign Telephone Company, and CT Communications, Inc. entered into a DSL Agreement. Attachment A of the agreement contains the "Basis of Compensation", which includes a discounted compensation amount which applies for high volume services. When CT Communications, Inc. has a monthly rental of 1,000 loops or more, the monthly rate is reduced to \$10.00 per loop.

The Champaign Telephone Company is proposing an amendment to Attachment A of the January 1, 2005 DSL Agreement, whereby, an additional discounted level of compensation will become effective for monthly rentals of 2,000 or more loops. The monthly discounted rate in recognition of such a high volume will be reduced to \$5.00 per loop.

If you are in agreement with the amendment to Attachment A, please sign where indicated at the bottom of the sheet and return a copy to my attention. This same offering will be available to other high volume users under the same terms and conditions found in the original agreement.

The following compensation amounts shall apply for services provided under the Agreement. These amounts shall be in effect until the Agreement is revised.

SERVICE PROVIDED

RATES

DSL Loops

\$19.50/month

The following discounted compensation amount shall apply for high volume services where CT Communications, Inc. orders a monthly rental of 1,000 loops up to 2,000.

\$10.00/month

The following discounted compensation amount shall apply for high volume services where CT Communications, Inc. orders a monthly rental of 2,000 loops or more.

\$ 5.00/month

The above rates are applicable in conjunction with the provisioning of DSL services by The Champaign Telephone Company.
