MCI Communications Services, Inc. d/b/a Verizon Business Services ("Verizon Business") is filing with your office an original and ten (10) copies of revisions to its P.U.C.O. Tariff No. 2.

Verizon Business proposes the following revisions and respectfully requests an effective date of January 1, 2008.

- Grandfathering of Option HHHHH (Verizon Business Services II) including the Verizon Business Services II rates under U.S. Private Line. Beginning January 1, 2008, Verizon Business Services II will no longer be available to new customers. Existing Verizon Business Services II customers will not be affected by this tariff change.
- Increase of the monthly recurring charge associated with Option ZZZ (Integrated RLA Service) and Option PPPP (Business B2 Integrated Service) in the Verizon (Zone 1) area. Affected customers were notified of the rate increases via an invoice message.

- 2.1.1.1.4 Digital Signal Level 1 (DS1) - A high capacity, point-to-point, private line service that transmits simultaneous full-duplex digital signals at 1.544 Mbps.
