ENTRY

The attorney examiner, in carrying out the authority granted by Rule 4901-1-14, Ohio Administrative Code (O.A.C.), finds:

- (1) By attorney examiner entry issued December 21, 2007, a procedural schedule was established for this proceeding, including a prehearing conference set for Tuesday, January 22, 2008, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The purpose of the prehearing conference will be to discuss the procedural aspects of the cases and to provide an opportunity for the parties to conduct settlement discussions.
- (2) Objections to the three Staff Reports were filed by several parties on January 3, 2008.
- (3) The evidentiary hearing for this proceeding shall start on Tuesday, January 29, 2008, at 10:00 a.m., at the offices of the Commission, 180 East Broad Street, 11th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215.
- (4) The local public hearings for this proceeding will be scheduled, and the publication of notice required, by subsequent entry.
- (5) On December 21, 2007, The Neighborhood Environmental Coalition (Coalition), The Consumers for Fair Utility Rates (Consumers), and The Empowerment Center of Greater Cleveland (Center) (jointly, The Citizens Coalition) filed a motion to intervene in this proceeding. The memorandum in support stated appropriate grounds for intervention. No memoranda contras were filed opposing intervention. Accordingly, the attorney examiner finds good cause to grant the motion to intervene.



ORDERED, That a copy of this Entry be served upon all parties of record in this proceeding.


