ENTRY

The Commission finds:

- (1) Ohio Gas Company ("Ohio Gas") is a public utility and natural gas company subject to the jurisdiction of this Commission by virtue of the provisions of Sections 4905.02 and 4905.03(A)(6), Revised Code.
- (2) On October 1, 2007, Ohio Gas and Gedert's Greenhouse, Inc. ("Gedert's") entered into a Transportation Agreement for Ohio Gas to provide interruptible natural gas transportation service to Gedert's to serve its facilities. Ohio Gas will act as transporter for gas delivered onto its system by Gedert's and redelivered onto Gedert's facilities as defined in the contract. This will be for a oneyear term starting October 1, 2007 and continuing thereafter from month to month.
- (3) The Commission has reviewed the application under the provisions of Section 4905.31, Revised Code, and finds that the proposed transportation agreement is reasonable and in the public interest and should be approved.

It is, therefore,

ORDERED, That the request for approval of an Interruptible Transportation Agreement between Ohio Gas and Gedert's is granted. It is, further,

ORDERED, That nothing in this Finding and Order shall be binding upon this Commission in any subsequent investigation or proceeding involving the justness or reasonableness of any rate, charge, rule, or regulation. It is, further,

OEDERED, That a copy of this Finding and Order be served upon Ohio Gas and Gedert's.
