SECTION 3 - DESCRIPTION OF SERVICE

3.1. TIMING OF CALLS

- 3.1.1. The subscriber's long distance usage charge is based on the actual usage of Company's service. Usage begins when the receiver of the called number is answered. The moment of the called party's answer is determined by hardware supervision in which the local telephone company sends a signal to the underlying carrier's switch or the software utilizing audio tone detection. The timing of the call occurs when called party answers and terminates when either party hangs up.
- 3.1.2. The minimum call duration for billing purposes differs between rate plans.
- 3.1.3. Usage is measured and rounded up to the next billing increment.
- 3.1.4. There is no billing for incomplete calls.

3.2. U.S. TELECOM TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

- 3.2.1 Company provides switched access, incumbent local exchange carrier-billed telecommunications services which allow commercial and residential Customers to establish a communications path between two stations by using uniform dialing plans.
- 3.2.2. "1 Plus" Commercial Long Distance Service Switched is a switched access service, offering commercial users outbound "1 plus" long distance telecommunications services from points originating and terminating within the State of Ohio.
- 3.2.3. **"1 Plus" Residential Long Distance Service Switched** is a switched access service, offering residential users outbound "1 plus" long distance telecommunications services from points originating and terminating within the State of Ohio.

Calling Card calls appear on the Customer's monthly long-distance bill.
- 3.2.5 Residential Local Exchange Carrier Calling Card Service permits residential Customers to charge the principal presubscribed location for a call placed while the Customer is away from the principal location when utilizing a calling card issued by an incumbent local exchange carrier, which does not provide interLATA services. The Customer may place calls from any dual tone multi-frequency phone in the United States by dialing a toll free number and entering a personal identification code, followed by the desired telephone number. Local Exchange Carrier Calling Card interLATA calls appear on the Customer's monthly long-distance bill.

The Company anticipated that it would at some point provide interexchange services. Since the grant of its intrastate operating authority in Ohio, the Company has focused its operations elsewhere. It has not developed nor provided retail interexchange services to the public and has no customers to notify, accordingly.

Should Applicant in the future provide retail telecommunications services in Ohio, the Company will post retail service descriptions and rates on its web site, as well as provide rate and service information to customers upon request and upon changes to applicable rates pursuant to Rule 4901:1-6-05(G).
