The attorney examiner finds:

- (1) On December 17, 2007, Weathersfield Township, Ohio (Complainant) filed a complaint against AT&T Ohio (AT&T), alleging numerous problems with communication lines installed by AT&T at Complainant's administration building in Mineral Ridge, Ohio. The problems, state Complainant, include but "are not limited to line noise, interference, and cost." Complainant adds that the lines "never worked properly and could not be utilized" by police and fire departments. Complainant seeks to be fully reimbursed for use of the telephone lines, as well as for "other maintenance, lost time, and other damages."
- (2) AT&T responded on January 7, 2008, by admitting that it provides telephone services to Complainant and that Complainant has reported problems concerning those services. AT&T adds, however, that it has reasonably responded to Complainant's reported problems and denies that it charged incorrect rates for Complainant's services at any time.
- (3) The attorney examiner concludes that this matter should be discussed further at a prehearing conference on February 4, 2008, at 1:30 P.M., in Room 11-A at the Commission offices, 180 East Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43215-3793.
