Revised tariff sheets have been filed with the FCC to amend Verizon Tariff FCC No. 14, Facilities for Interstate Access, in which Verizon North Inc. concurs for intrastate applications.

Transmittal No. 890 – Effective January 31, 2008 With this transmittal, Verizon is revising FCC No. 14 to introduce a new contract tariff option (Contract Option). This new Contract Option will provide a customer with billing credits and other benefits on certain Special Access Services when the customer maintains a minimum in total billed revenue for the services included in the new Contract Option and meets other criteria as specified.
