McKenzie, Director-Regulatory and John D. Sisemore, Director-Regulatory. The oral depositions will commence and continue one after the other on February 5, 2008 at the offices of the OCC (10 W. Broad Street, 18th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215) at 10:00 a.m. Eastern Time or another time and place that is mutually agreed upon by the parties. Deponents will appear at designated time with documents at OCC and remain present until the deposition has been completed.

The deposition will be taken of the aforementioned deponents on relevant topics within the scope of this proceeding, including but not limited to, the subject matter of the




